

# Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Hospital

## At A Glance

Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Hospital, a Saint Francis *Care* provider, is a 60-bed comprehensive medical rehabilitation facility located on the north campus of Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center.

Established in 1995 as The Rehabilitation Hospital of Connecticut, the name was changed to Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Hospital in 2006 in recognition of the fifteen-year anniversary of the affiliation between Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center and the former Mount Sinai Hospital.

The Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Hospital provides a comprehensive range of intensive programs designed to prevent and minimize chronic disabilities and to assist people in rebuilding their lives after catastrophic illnesses and injuries. Major programs include: traumatic brain injury, stroke/neurological rehabilitation, sports medicine and general rehabilitation, including spinal cord injury and orthopedics.

The Mount Sinai Rehabilitation Hospital's facilities include a general rehabilitation unit, a brain injury unit, dedicated inpatient and outpatient therapy areas, a therapeutic pool, an activities of daily living center, a transitional living apartment and other simulated environments.
